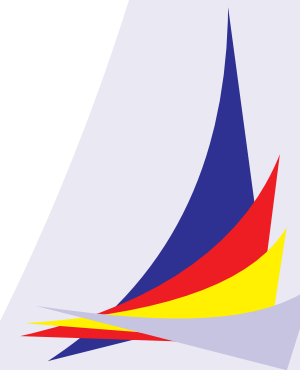

By Road: Shirpur is 50 km away from Dhule and 200 km from Indore (MP), Surat (Gujarat), Nasik and Aurangabad (MH). Buses are available from Jalgaon (100 km) and Bhusawal to Shirpur. Buses run between Dhule and Shirpur. Well connected by road through Mumbai-Agra National Highway (NH-3).
